



## Pfizer Ireland Consolidate CoreAccess Across Their Manufacturing Facilities

Pfizer Ireland have successfully completed a consolidation of the Business Critical CoreAccess Enterprise Security Management Solution merging three individual installations into a centralised database. This represents the continued expansion of the CoreAccess System since its initial deployment in the Pfizer Ringaskiddy facility in 1995. Pfizer Inc., is one of the world's premier research-based pharmaceutical companies with operations in more than 150 countries.

To implement the Project a joint project team was formed of TDS and Pfizer Staff. As part of the centralisation the opportunity was taken to review business processes, cleanse data and determine operational efficiencies. The latest version of CoreAccess was installed on the Oracle 10G platform.

The centralised database encompasses all elements of Access Control including:

- ID Card Production
- Real-Time Emergency Headcounting
- Alarm Monitoring
- Visitor / Contractor Management
- Time & Attendance Integration

The consolidation provides Pfizer Ireland with the following key benefits:

- The ability to provide controlled access for Card Holders to any of the three manufacturing facilities.
- Devolved Management of Access Control profiles for colleagues, visitors and contractors.
- A single card for use across the three manufacturing facilities.
- Reduced support and IT Administration costs.
- A common Visitor Management interface across the sites providing consistent visitor control and improved visitor experience.
- The capacity to add new sites as and when required. Already plans are in place to add the new Pfizer Biopharma facility in Shanbally and the Pfizer Manufacturing plant in Dun Laoighaire.
- A single Backup/Disaster Recovery Plan that will ensure continued business operations in the event of a failure.
- Autonomous management of Access Control for each of the facilities whilst providing an overall view of the Corporation for authorised personnel.
- Consistency of data for reporting purposes across the three facilities.
- A single upgrade will apply to all sites reducing the overheads associated with upgrades.
