## Trinity College Select TDS' Student Attendance Solution

This 'mobile' information will then be downloaded using Bluetooth Technology to the database for reporting purposes.

The **CoreSA** Solution fully interface's with Trinity College's CMIS Student System to populate the required student data to the Student Attendance System. The automated reports produced detail attendance percentages, thus eliminating the time consuming paper based methods of recording attendance. A random head count 'class sheet' can be also be produced containing student photo, name, number, bar code and signature line for spot checking and exam purposes.

A key feature for Trinity College was the automatic SMS text functionality which notifies a student once their attendance drops below the specified threshold.
