In the event of an emergency or evacuation, people can 'swipe if safe' at a predetermined intelligent device in a safe area. A real-time 'missing list' is produced which is reduced as each person swipes at the designated safety points.

With a high onus put on research centres today an important factor for Tyndall when implementing the **CoreCampus** solution was the protection of sensitive and valuable information.
